



## Welcome to Revolution Dance



Welcome to Revolution Dance – we are excited that you have decided to join us for our Dance Technique Classes! Important information about your registration and some FAQ's are listed below.

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Classes are in session August 21<sup>st</sup> through May 18<sup>th</sup> with no classes on the following dates due to holidays – all other dates classes will be in session:

- November 20<sup>th</sup> – 24<sup>th</sup> (Thanksgiving Break)
- December 25<sup>th</sup> – January 5<sup>th</sup> (Winter Break)
- March 12<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup> (Spring Break)

Your monthly tuition is based on the 35-week session and will be billed at a consistent monthly rate exclusive of actual weeks in an individual month; tuition will not be prorated for missed classes but each student will be allowed (2) makeup class options each semester – please schedule these with us in advance to make sure there is room in the class you wish to attend; minimum enrollment is required and classes may be combined and/or split if necessary - we will inform you in advance if this is necessary for your class.

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**PAYMENT:** All students MUST be enrolled in our automatic billing program. Forms to register for payment are available online and at the studio. An initial invoice will be emailed to you upon registration to inform you of what your consistent monthly billing will be (remember it is the same amount each month as the tuition is based on the full session regardless of actual weeks in each month). If you need to make any adjustments to your registration or withdraw from classes you must notify us in writing prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month. Credit/Debit Cards will be processed on approximately the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month (dependent on weekends and holidays). If you prefer to pay with cash/check we MUST receive payment prior to the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month or the card on file will be charged. A late fee of \$15 per month will be applied to invoices for declined credit cards and/or NSF. August classes will be billed on your September invoice and processed on September 1<sup>st</sup>

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**PERFORMANCES:** There will be various opportunities for dance performances throughout the year – these are OPTIONAL for students enrolled and may require additional fees to participate. There will be a performance opportunity in the Fall and all classes will have the opportunity to perform in our Year-End Dance Showcase scheduled for May 2018 at Grand Junction High School Auditorium. The year-end performance will require additional fees for costumes and will be applied to your March invoices. If a student is not planning to participate in the year-end dance showcase, please notify us in writing before March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018 to avoid being charged for these costume fees. Other additional performance fees will be applied as needed.

## Dress Code for Dance Classes

### Dress Code for Dance Classes

A dress code ensures that a teacher will be able to see a dancer's alignment and positioning to allow for corrections for student growth and safety. Pink or light-colored tights also make the lines of the legs visible. A dress code also helps teach students discipline and enhances overall focus and energy of dancers. By "dressing the part," dancers feel like dancers.

#### Young Dancers Program:

Girls: Leotard and tights with ballet shoes or bare feet – dance skirts and attached leo/skirts are acceptable; hair needs to be pulled up and out of face

Boys: clothes that allow for movement and ballet shoes or bare feet

#### Primary Technique Dance Program: *No jeans, dresses, or skirts are allowed in any dance class*

Ballet: solid colored leotard and tights; ballet shoes; hair pulled back and secured

Jazz: leotard or tight fitting tank and dance pants, shorts, or tights; jazz shoes, foot thongs, or bare feet; hair secured

Tap: tap shoes, comfortable clothing that allows for movement

Boys in Ballet and Jazz: Solid colored tank top; above the knee athletic shorts or dance pants; appropriate shoes

Hip Hop: clothes that allow for movement and clean tennis shoes/dance shoes (jeans are not allowed)

Funk and Rhythm: clothes that allow for movement and clean tennis shoes/dance shoes or bare feet

Modern: leotard or tight fitting tank; dance pants, shorts, or tights; hair pulled back and secured; appropriate footing

Adult and Specialty Classes: clothes that allow for movement and appropriate dance shoes

We recommend purchasing shoes and dancewear at Discount Dance ([www.DiscountDance.com](http://www.DiscountDance.com)) – **You will receive a 10% discount if you use our discount code: TP48134** - and the studio gets credit for your purchase! If you prefer to shop locally Target, Walmart, and Payless Shoes usually have a stock of basic clothing and shoes.
